The National Museum of the Marine Corps in Quantico, VA is the centerpiece of the Marine Corps Heritage Center drawing more than 500,000 people annually.

The two-story, 120,000-square-foot facility features museum gallery space, an orientation theater, gift shop, cafeteria, kitchen, tavern, and an expansive entry lobby/atrium.

Our initial scope included an overall evaluation and general recommendations for museum audio and video systems in addition to acoustical measurements and recommendations for the main pavilion. Once funds were raised for this non-profit organization, we completed the design for audio and video and commissioned the systems for the facility.
